



Product Recall Update

Dear Valued Patients and Guardians,

It has come to our attention that The Quaker Oats Company recently issued a recall for several snack and cereal bar products due to potential contamination with Salmonella. This includes the Cap'n Crunch Quaker Treat Bars distributed during the December 15, 2023, Pedaling for Smiles event in Greenville, PA.

Salmonella infection symptoms may include fever, bloody diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, and abdominal pain. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is actively investigating to identify the source of the contamination.

Immediate Action Required:

- 1. Dispose of Recalled Products:** Please promptly dispose of any Quaker Oats Company snacks and cereal bars affected by the recall. A detailed list of recalled products can be found at <http://www.quakerrecallusa.com/>.
- 2. Check Your Homes:** As these products may have a long shelf life, we urge you to thoroughly check your homes for any recalled items and discard them immediately.
- 3. Seek Medical Attention:** If you or anyone in your household experiences symptoms such as diarrhea, nausea, or vomiting, we strongly recommend contacting your healthcare provider promptly.
