



Product Recall Update

Dear Patients and Guardians,

We are reaching out to inform you of a recent recall involving Newmemo Children's Ring Sets, which may pose a health risk to children. These sets have been found to contain lead levels exceeding federal safety standards and cadmium levels prohibited in children's products.

Recall Details:

- **Product:** Newmemo Children's Ring Sets
- **Description:** The sets contain 36 rings in various designs, packaged in a pink heart-shaped display case. A white label on the underside of the case includes "Newmemo" and "Amazon FNSKU X0034COQMP."
- **Sales Period:** These were sold exclusively on Amazon from January 2022 through March 2024 for approximately \$12.

What You Should Do:

- **Stop Using the Rings:** Please immediately remove the recalled rings from children's access.
- **Contact Newmemo for a Refund:** You can request a full refund by reaching out to Newmemo directly. They will also ask you to dispose of the recalled jewelry and send a photo of the disposed product to cly2167@163.com.
- **Testing for Exposure:** We recommend considering testing for lead and cadmium exposure, especially if your child has used these products.
